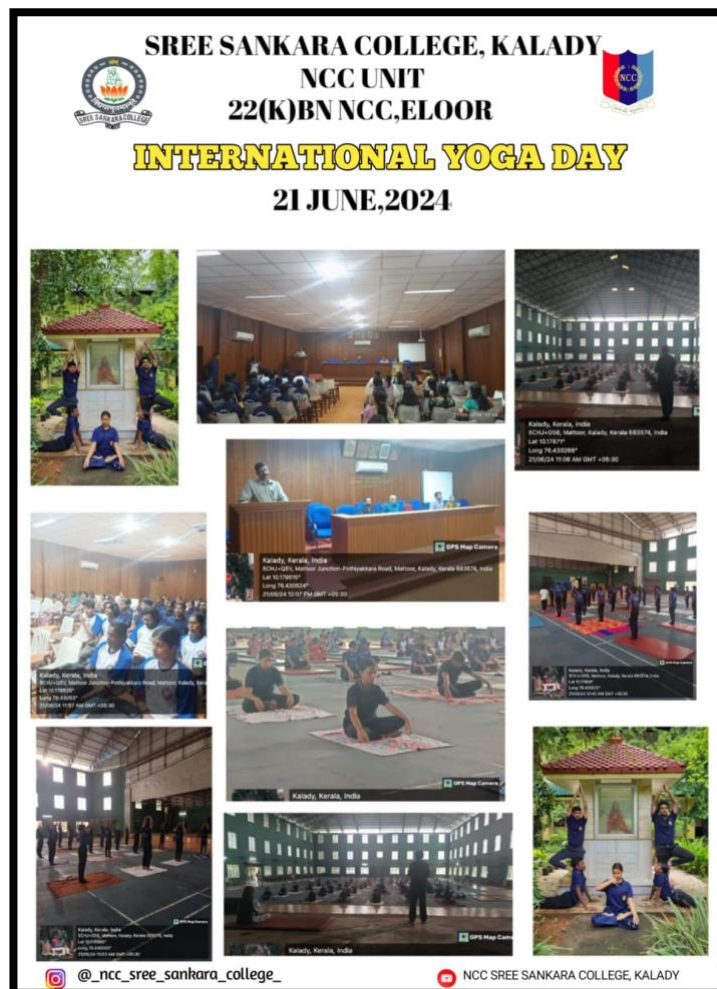

JUNE 21, 2024

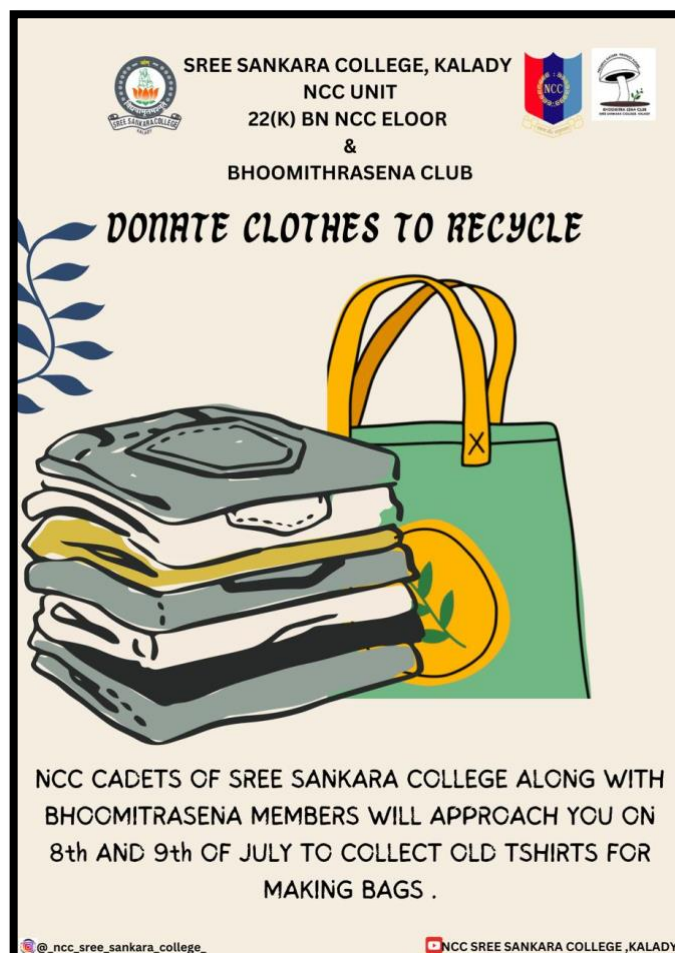

JULY 03, 2024

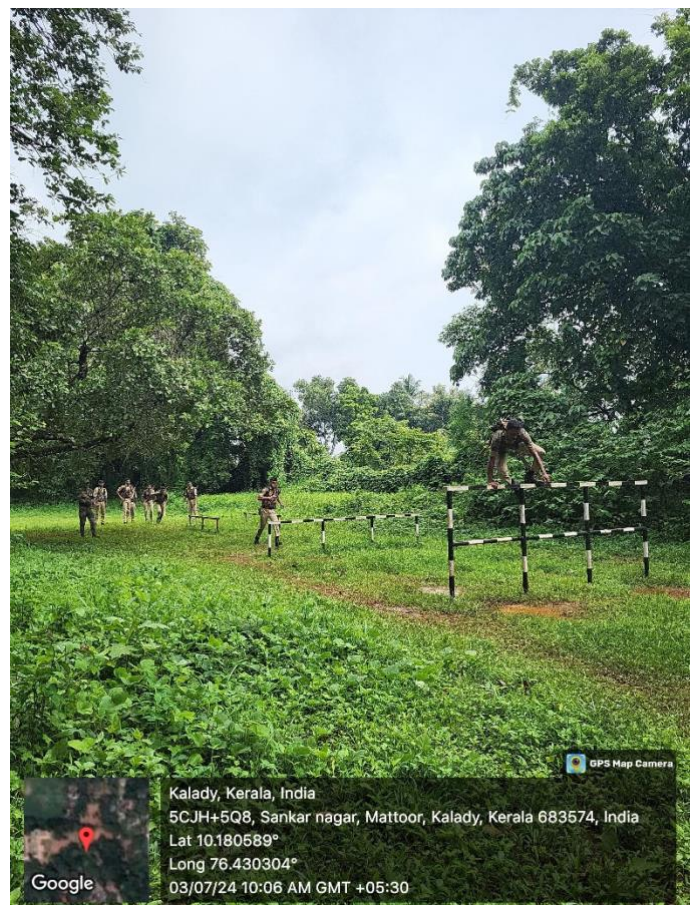

OCTOBER 17, 2024

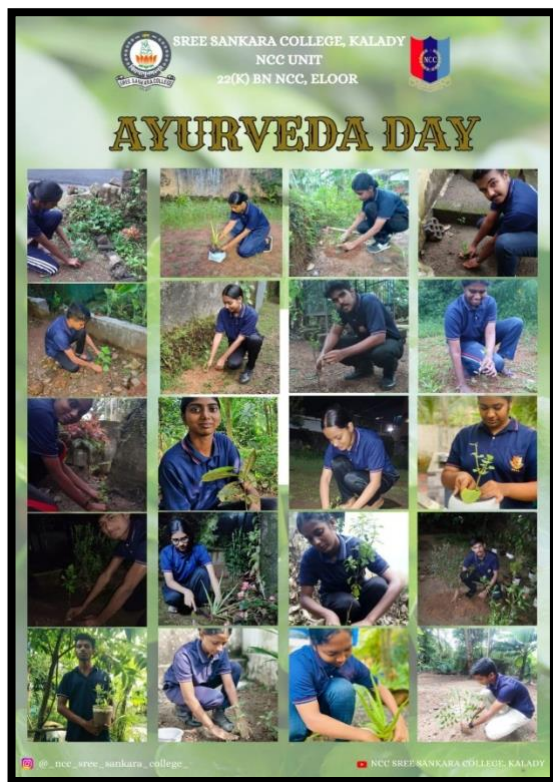

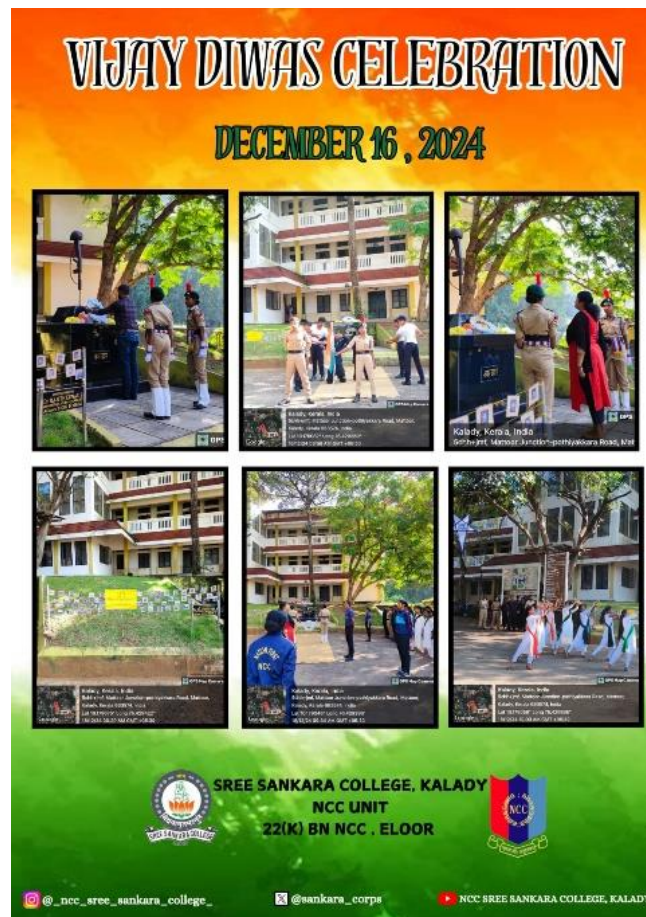
NCC DAY CELEBRATION CLEANING DRIVE

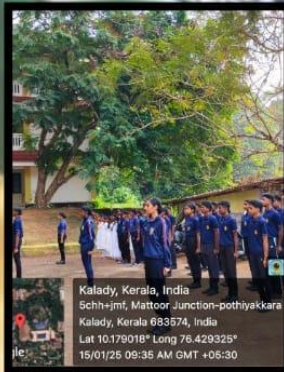

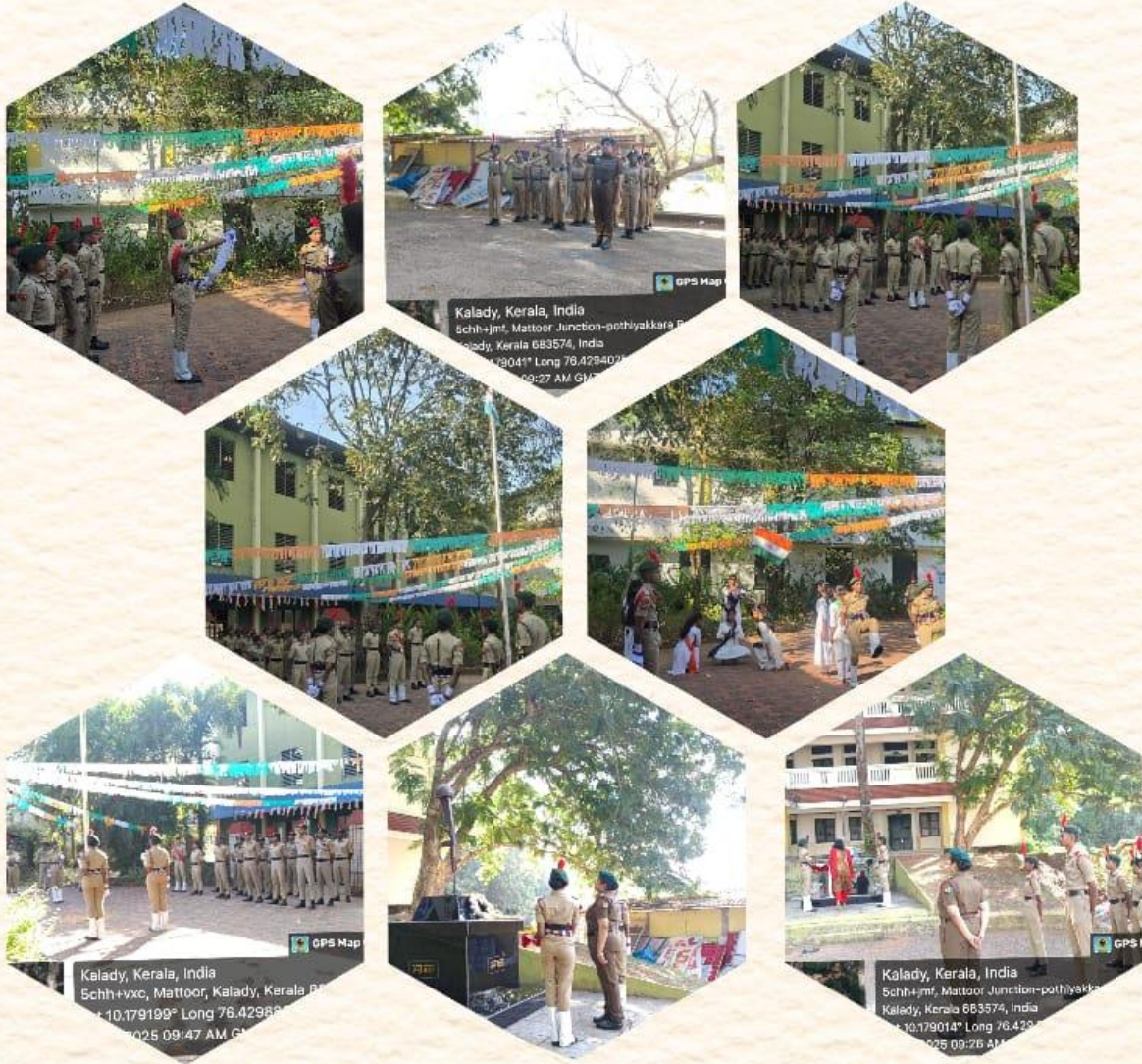
24. REPUBLIC DAY

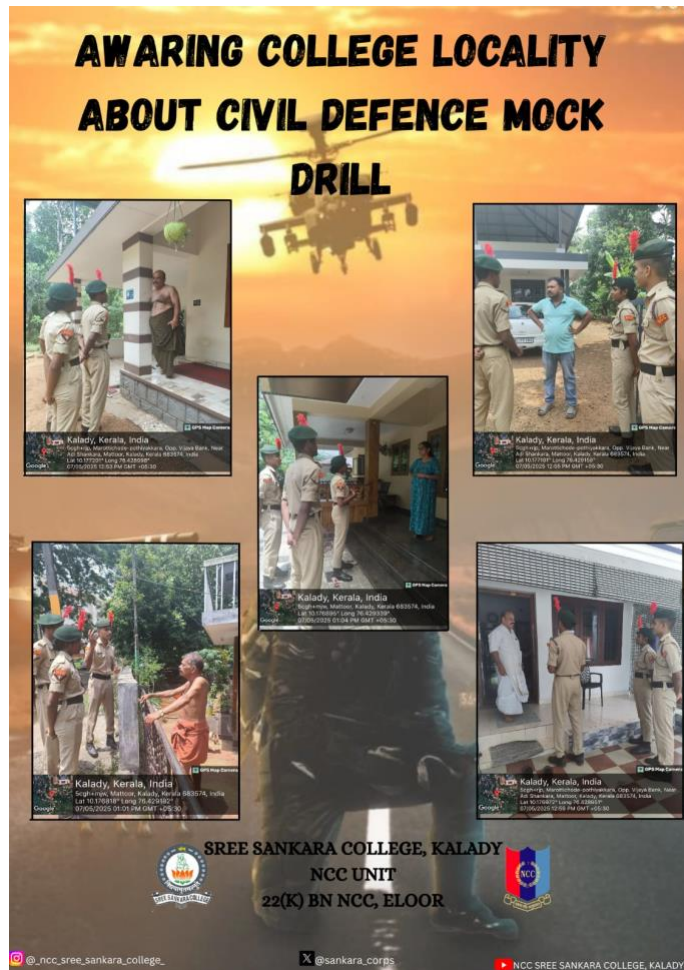
